

## CURRICULUM VITAE OF GERASIMOS ZORAS

Gerasimos Zoras is Professor of the Faculty of Italian Language and Literature at the University of Athens, Greece. He holds an M.A. (1981) and a Ph.D. (1991) in Philology at the same University, and he also holds a post-doc (1992) in Italian Literature, as a result of a scientific research that he elaborated at the Academy "Arcadia" of Rome. His teaching and research interests are Italian and Comparative Literature. He has written more than 200 articles and more than ten books. Some of his books are: *-Ελληνόγλωσσα στιχουργήματα Ιταλών λογίων (ΙΖ'-ΙΘ' αιώνες). Η Ακαδημία Arcadia της Ρώμης και η ελληνική παράδοση* (1993), *-Ιταλικοί αντικατοπτρισμοί. Η Ιταλία σε κείμενα Νεοελλήνων λογοτεχνών* (1994), *-Θύβρις* (1999), *-Αυσονία* (2000), *-Risonanze italiane nel mare Ionio. Testi in italiano di poeti delle Isole Ionie* (Roma 2001), *-Ιταλοί λογοτέχνες στο έργο του Παλαμά* (2004), *-Η Ιταλία του Βασίλη Βασιλικού* (2009).

He is member of several scientific societies and he is also vice president of three of them: National Society of Greek Writers (2012), "Parnassos" Literary Association (2014), and Conservatory of Athens (2011). He is member of scientific and editorial boards of several scientific journals in Greece and Italy (*-Sincronie. Rivista semestrale di letteratura, teatro e sistemi di pensiero*, *-Linguistica e Letteratura. Rivista semestrale*, *-Letteratura Italiana Antica. Rivista annuale di testi e studi*). The President of the Italian Republic awarded him the medal of Cavaliere (2002) and he is elected Member of the Academy "Arcadia" of Rome (1993) and Honorary Member of Società Dantesca Italiana of Florence (2010).
